Oregon PTA Regions

A PTA Region is a geographic area within the state of Oregon. Oregon is currently comprised of 9 service regions. Each region is represented on the Oregon PTA Board of Directors by an elected Region Director. In addition to voicing the views of local unit members from their region at Board of Directors' meetings, it is the task of the Region Director to provide guidance, networking opportunities, and to help coordinate the activities of the local PTA/PTSA units within their particular region. Region II West Multnomah County (Portland Public Schools)
Region III Benton, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Polk, and Tillamook (Pacific City only) Counties
Region IV Clackamas County
Region V Multnomah County (except Portland Public School District) and Hood River County
Region VI Douglas and Lane Counties
Region VIII Jackson, Josephine, Coos, and Curry Counties
Region IX Baker, Gilliam, Grant, Morrow, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, and Wasco Counties
Region X Crook, Deschutes, Harney, Jefferson, Malheur, Wheeler, Klamath and Lake Counties

- Maintains a library of videotapes and other materials for use by local units.

It includes reports of PTA activities (local, state, and national) such as membership, leadership, current federal legislation relating to PTA priority concerns, National PTA Convention, and PTA policies and procedures.
